REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER CAMP 2012

Registration for Summer Camp 2012 is now underway!! Once again, we are pleased to offer significant Priority Registration discounts to our returning camp families with payment **IN FULL** by Friday, September 2, 2011.

Registration is on a first come, first served basis for returning families for all Camp Periods. With many campers increasing the length of their stay at Camp each year, we are unable to commit to holding spaces from one year to the next.



LAST AUGUST, CLOSE TO 80% OF AVAILABLE SPACES FOR THE 2011 SEASON WERE BOOKED BY RETURNING FAMILIES BY MID-AUGUST!!!

There are many new families that have expressed interest in Wenonah for 2012 (or have been on waiting lists for the 2011 season). These families will be offered available spaces beginning September 6, 2011 for the 2012 camping season (if any space remains).

Wenonah Associate Director Caron Brick and Wenonah Co-Director Mike Stewart (first two weeks of August) will be at the Burlington Office accepting 2012 Summer Camp registrations during July and August 2011. When registrations are received, they will be entered in order of receipt and families will be contacted by phone or email for confirmation of their registration(s).

POLARIS & WCIT REGISTRATIONS – 2012 SEASON

All registration for the 2012 POLARIS & WCIT programs is on a “first come, first served” basis.

We encourage families to register as soon as possible for our 2012 leadership programs as all of our 2011 programs filled by the end of the first week in August of 2010. We have over 75 POLARIS participants in 2011 with WCIT space in 2012 limited to 25 WCITs each month.

ANOTHER GREAT YEAR AT CAMP!

It has certainly been a busy season so far! Here are just a few of the highlights of the 2011 season:

- Our international camper and staff numbers continue to grow with close to 100 attending Wenonah in 2011 from Mexico, Venezuela, France, Spain, the United Kingdom, Belgium, Italy, Singapore, Taiwan, Turkey, Anguilla, Martinique, South Korea, Australia, and the United States (Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, New York, Missouri). Canadian campers and staff are attending Wenonah in 2011 from British Columbia, Quebec, Alberta and across Ontario. Plans are already underway for our first Russian campers to attend Wenonah in 2012!
- Two new PICO sailboats purchased.
- Expanded sailing docks.
- New main canoe dock installed at canoeing.
- Fans installed in the Main Lodge (great for those VERY hot Summer days!)
- The Walk-in Fridge was completely refurbished. A new Walk-in freezer is being installed in the Fall.
- After a greater amount of interest this year than usual for introductory/short stay programs, Periods 3A & 3B have been introduced to run concurrently with Period Three (first two weeks of August Camp).
