## WENONAH LEADS PROGRAM AT CAIS CONFERENCE

In October, Wenonah helped facilitate a program for the Heads and Chairs of Canada's independent schools at the Canadian Association of Independent Schools Annual Conference. The program provided a unique approach to educational workshops. It was designed to challenge Conference delegates to work as a team, communicate, coordinate, and to "think outside the box". Delegates were provided with team building tools to encourage their students to learn in a fun and meaningful way.

A terrific group of Wenonah volunteers made the program a great success. Our volunteers included several 2009 POLARIS and WCITs, staff members, and representatives from our Friends of Wenonah alumni group. Our volunteers are to be commended for the great job they did in facilitating a truly unique program!

## 2010: A LOOK AHEAD!

As we now turn our attention to planning for another successful season in 2010, here are just a few of the projects and initiatives that we are working towards:

- A dramatic post-and-beam addition to the Main Lodge with seating for 60-80. This expansion will feature breathtaking new views of Clear Lake.
- Following up on the great success of our Period Five and WEEnonah programs, we are pleased to launch two new introductory periods for first time campers. Periods 1A and 1B are six day programs for campers 7 – 13 years of age. Campers will sample traditional Wenonah programs during Periods 1A and 1B.
- A revised WCIT program will allow participants to focus on specific "streams" that interest them. These streams will include opportunities for Cabin, Outtrip, or Program-based leadership development.
- Introduction of a white water kayak program for experienced paddlers.
- Watch for an introduction of several new PIC areas in 2010 including a new creative program focussing on voice/vocal music.



Numerous other programs, projects and initiatives are being considered and will be approved over the next few months. Watch for more details in the January 2010 Warbler!
