## By April 1, 2010

- Final payment for all Camp Fees received by Burlington Office

## By April 30, 2010:

- Download and read Final Instructions Handbook
- Complete all camper forms online:
  - Final Instructions Package Icon at the top of Camp News page for online forms
  - Camper Information and Health Form (*please mail a copy of your child's Health Card to the Burlington Office*)
  - PIC Pre-Selection Form (*for campers only—not available for P1A, P1B, P5, WEEnonah, POLARIS or WCITs*)
  - Incidentals Booking Form (*including transportation information*)
- Final payment for all Incidental Fees (including bus, General Store, White Water Kayaking, Outtrips, Laundry and Paddleblank purchases) received by the Burlington Office

*\*\* Note that we do not guarantee cabinmate requests, outtrip requests, paddleblank purchases, laundry service, PIC selections or Highway Coach bus booking, if received after April 30. Forms submitted after April 30<sup>th</sup> are subject to HST.*

## New Campers and Families:

## One Week in Advance of Camp:

- Any changes to travel arrangements to and from Camp must be made to the Muskoka Office
- Check your child for Head Lice
- Label all clothing and items sent to Camp; follow packing instructions found in Final Instructions Handbook
- Do NOT send any snacks with your camper. Campers visit the General Store every other day.
- Check website for any updates before and during Camp.
- Alert the Camp if your child has been exposed to any communicable disease (within three weeks of the start of their Camp Period)

## First Day of Camp:

- Update medical information if necessary (in writing, to the attention of the HEAD NURSES)
- Carefully detail in writing the normal practice for dispensing medication; send this information with medication in original container
- Ensure dispensing instructions are translated to English
- Bus leaves Vaughan Mills Mall at 8:00am. Your camper must be there by 7:30am.
- For those driving to Camp please arrive at 11:00am.

## During Camp:

- Parents may write letters, send one e-mail per day, and one fax per week
- Campers cannot call home or return e-mails, but are encouraged to write letters
- Care packages must be limited to envelopes and should NOT contain food
- International Campers may purchase phone cards in the Wenonah General Store

## Last Day of Camp:

- If you are picking your child up at Camp by car, meet them at their cabin at 10:30am and collect their envelope of information (including cabin photo) from the counsellor
- Bus returns to Vaughan Mills Mall at 12:30pm

## 2011 Registration:

- 2011 Priority Registration begins in mid July through September 1, 2010 and is on a first-come, first-served basis - spots fill QUICKLY
