REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER CAMP 2020

Registration for all 2020 Camp Wenonah Summer Camp Periods begins Tuesday, July 9, 2019

Wenonah Director of Administration Caron Brick along with Outdoor Centre Director Rianne Barette are at the Burlington Office accepting 2020 Summer Camp applications during July and August 2020. When applications are received, they are entered in order of receipt and families receive an automatic email as confirmation of their application(s).

Please note, as always, we are offering our Priority Registration fees with discounts until Friday, September 6, 2019.

ROOTS, POLARIS & WCIT REGISTRATIONS – 2020 SEASON

All registration for the 2020 ROOTS, POLARIS & WCIT programs are on a “first come, first served” basis. We encourage families to register as soon as possible for our 2020 leadership programs as all of our 2019 programs saw registration that put us very close to capacity by mid-August 2018. We filled completely to capacity in early Fall 2018 for the 2109 season with 160 ROOTS spots, over 80 POLARIS participants and WCITs numbering over 50. **We have NO PLANS to further increase capacity in any of these programs at this point.**

2019: FINAL YEAR FOR PERIOD FIVE/INTRODUCTION OF 4A IN 2020

Wenonah is thrilled to be the permanent host site for Camp Kivita, Canada's Summer Camp for children with solid organ transplants – heart, kidney, liver, lung and bowel, as well as for those living with organ failure. For many years, Kivita has been a standalone program integrated within the third week of August Camp.

In recent years, Kivita has grown in size with significant annual wait lists. Beginning in 2020, Kivita will move to the traditional Period Five slot on our schedule (the ninth week of Summer Camp) and will have exclusive use of Camp during this time. It means that we have a terrific opportunity to add a new program during the third week of August Camp. And beginning in 2020, we will have a new program in place, 4A, for 8-12 year olds (helping with huge demand for these introductory programs currently running as Periods 1A and 3A).

NEW FOR 2020: TWO ADDITIONAL WEENONAH PROGRAMS

With Camp Kivita moving to the ninth week of our Summer Camp season, we have also decided to move the WEEnonah program to the third week of August Camp beginning in 2020. This move brings some great news. We're able to add TWO additional WEEnonah programs in 2020. This will help immensely with the demand for WEEnonah (typically WEEnonah has filled for the next season within a few days of registration opening...a full year out!).
